Benson Analytics Module

- Benson is a community focused analytics, benchmarking and planning hub
- Extensively testing with 12 provider sites over 6 years
- Benson allows providers to fully leverage their data to produce objective insights that drive change
- New UK benchmarking service started in 2023
- Benson is affordable, low maintenance and works with all systems



How does it work?

- Users access the reports online
- Data is uploaded by P&I rep and refreshed monthly
- Data is processed automatically overnight
- Reports include:
 - Insight report (internal teams)
 - Benchmarking report (providers)
- Once setup Benson requires 1-2 hours of P&I team time to upload the raw data



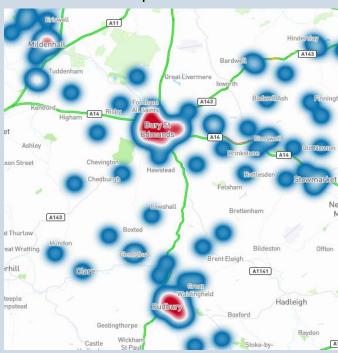




Benson in West Suffolk

- Deployed at WSFT since 2019
- WSFT are part of the provider steering group
- WSFT now has 28 individual users across Operations, Management, Infomatics and Transformation
- We will focus on key areas of influence that Benson has had including:
 - Case study 1: Redesign of Skill Mix
 - Case study 2: Service Level Reviews
 - Case study 3: Application of external Benchmarking

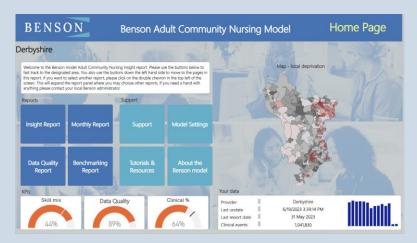
Live referral hotspots



Access

- Originally core leadership team
- Access extended to team leaders and senior nurses
- WSFT users access the online reports via our client portal
- There are two reports
 - Insight report (internal)
 - Benchmarking report (external)
- Users can apply filters to customise reports
- Using the visuals for presentations and reports
- As a prerequisite Benson users need a clear understanding of data quality

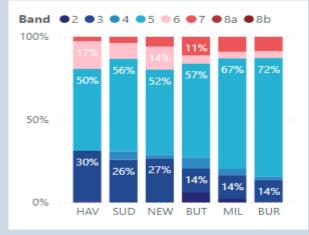

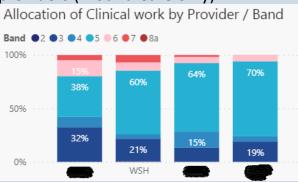
Case Study 1: New Skill Mix strategy

- The benchmarking provided a new objective perspective
- Informed a business case to increase skill mix
- Demonstrates increased demand on services and evidence the need for additional funding
- Supported new skill mix approach ensuring both safe & cost effective
- Helped introduce new skills to lower bands
- Managers track changes in these outcomes from Benson reports

Case Study 2: Service Level Reviews

- Each CN team have a six-monthly SLR
- They prepare and report their metrics to the executive
- Benson provides evidence of each team's productivity, effectiveness, & risk profile
- e.g. Bury Town (see visuals)
 - High productivity
 - However their re-referral rates are high
 - Are they spread too thin?
- Flags potential issues with team quality and performance

Case Study 3: Applying Benchmarking

- The Benchmarking report allows WSFT to compare performance with other providers
- Evidences demand / capacity and provides objective comparison to reassure Exec
- Helps communications with Execs in ICB / assurance
- Provide reassurance to teams
- Evidences strengths and positive outcomes
- Benson reflects CNSST outcomes

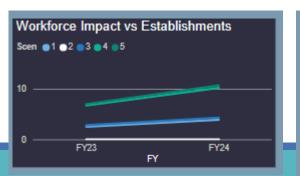


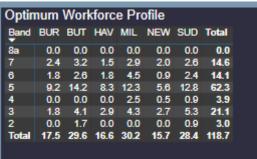

Service Planning module

- WSFT have also applied the planning module to:
 - Model future demand
 - Predict future workload
 - Build and run new service scenarios
 - Predict workforce requirements for future years that reflect the complexity in each team
- •The planning module takes the baseline service model and applies demand expectations
- Scenario planning allows predicted impacted of changes in delivery model and deployment of new technology
- Helps target future financial sustainability

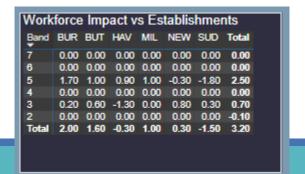
